- Tæt samarbejde med North Sea Commission og Baltic Sea Commission



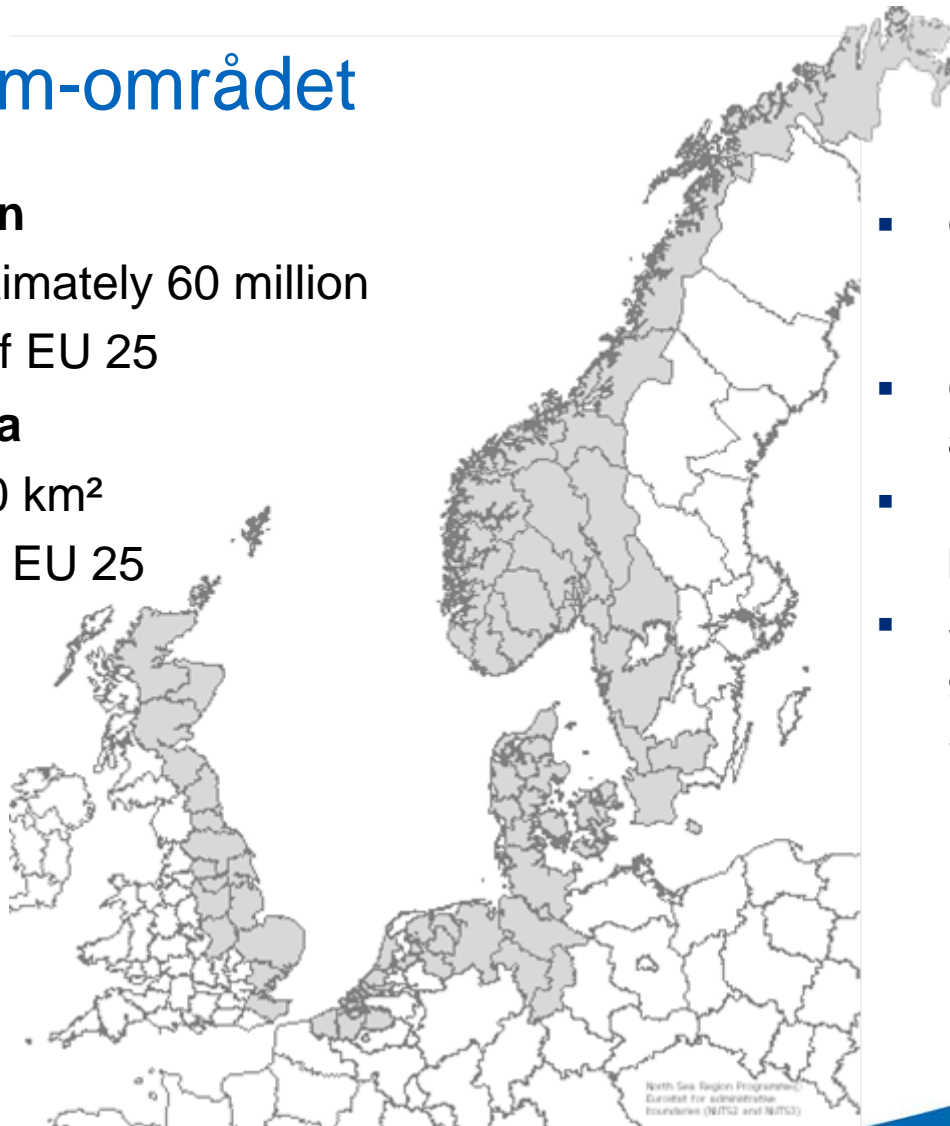
Program-området

99,6% of enterprises are SME's

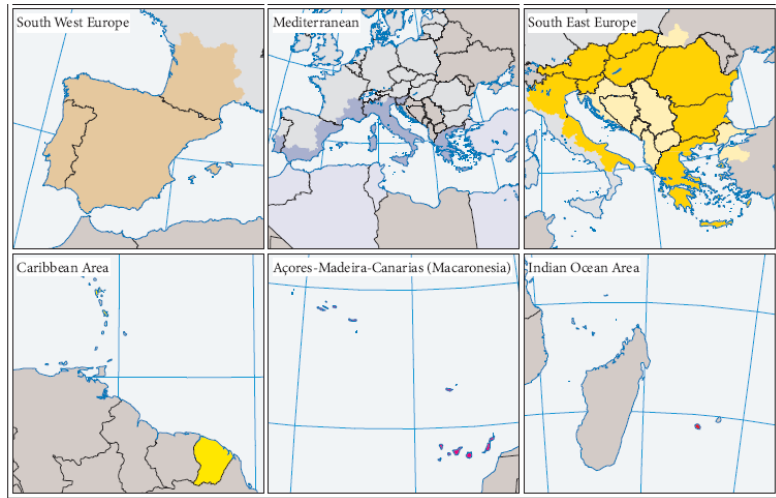
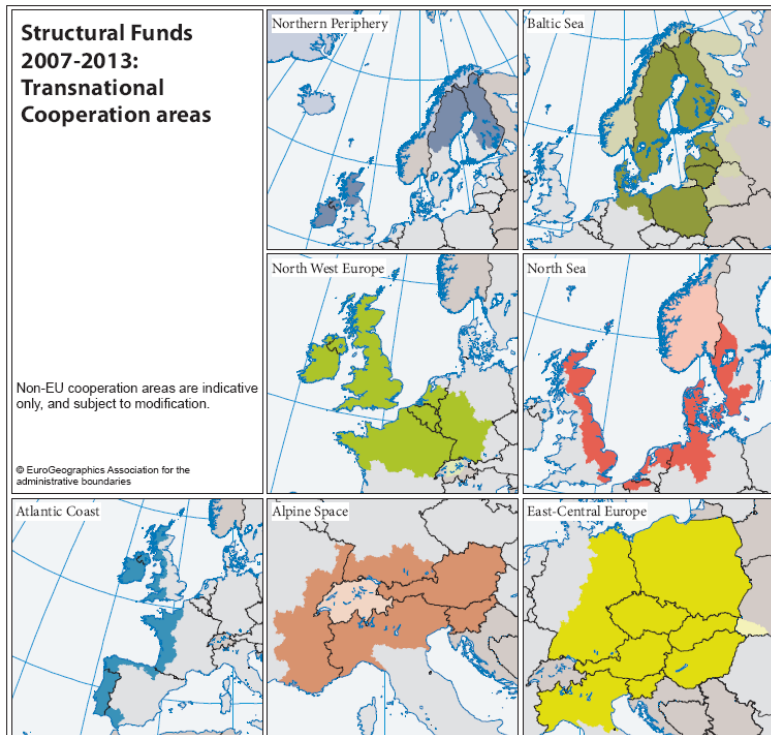


Fakta om Nordsø-området

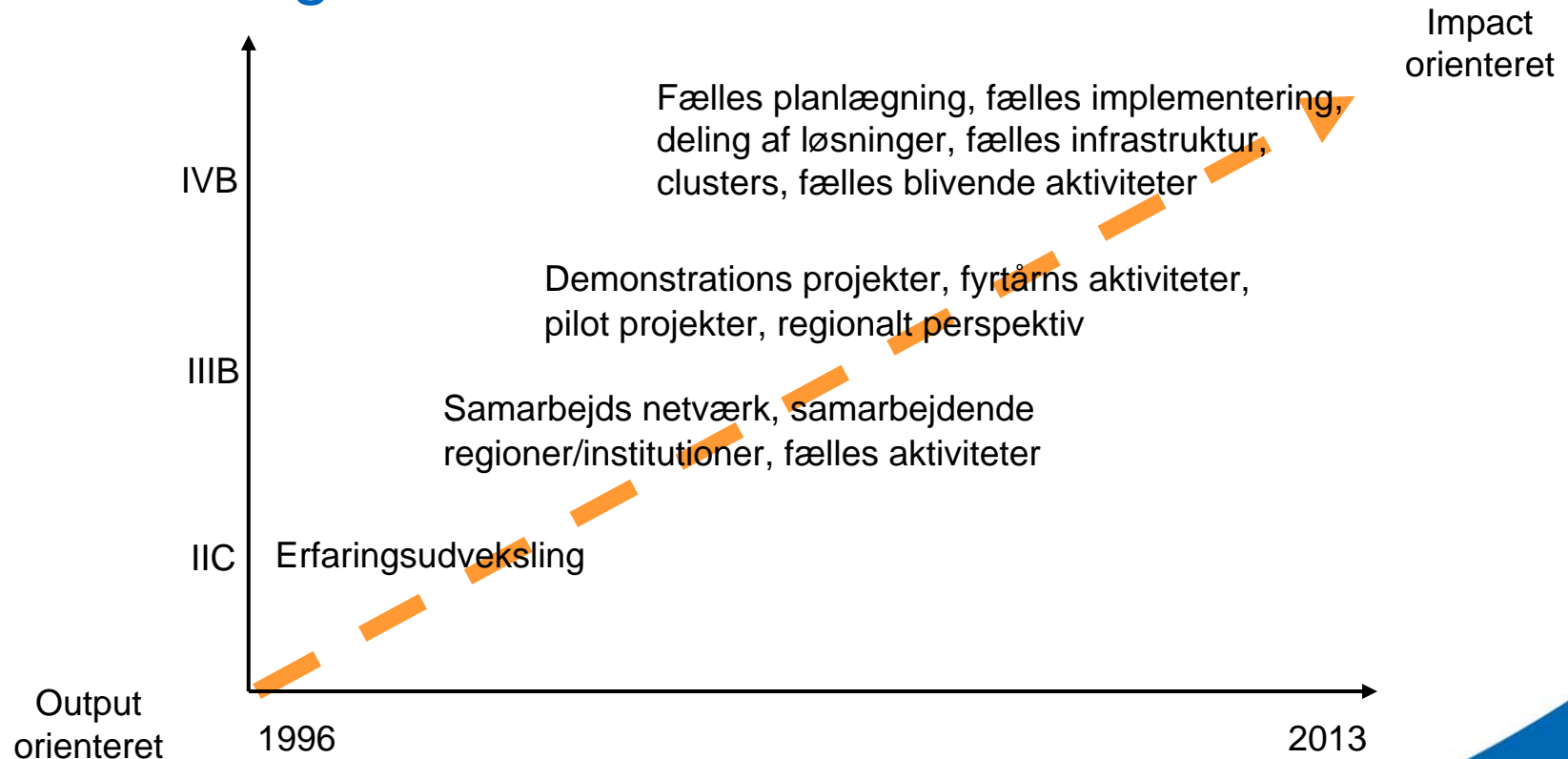


Transnationalt samarbejde

Transnationalt samarbejde – Udvikling i aktiviteter





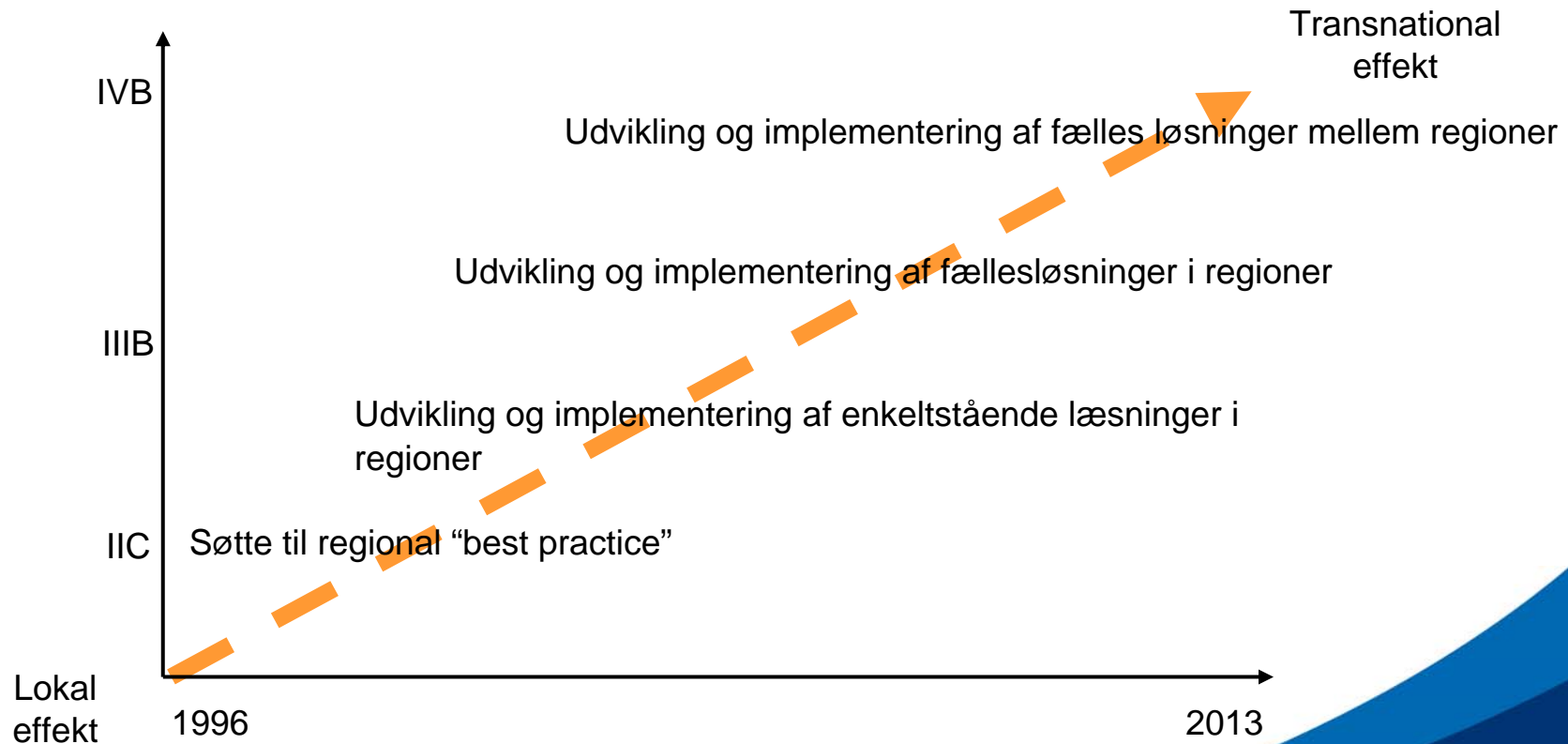
Investeringer

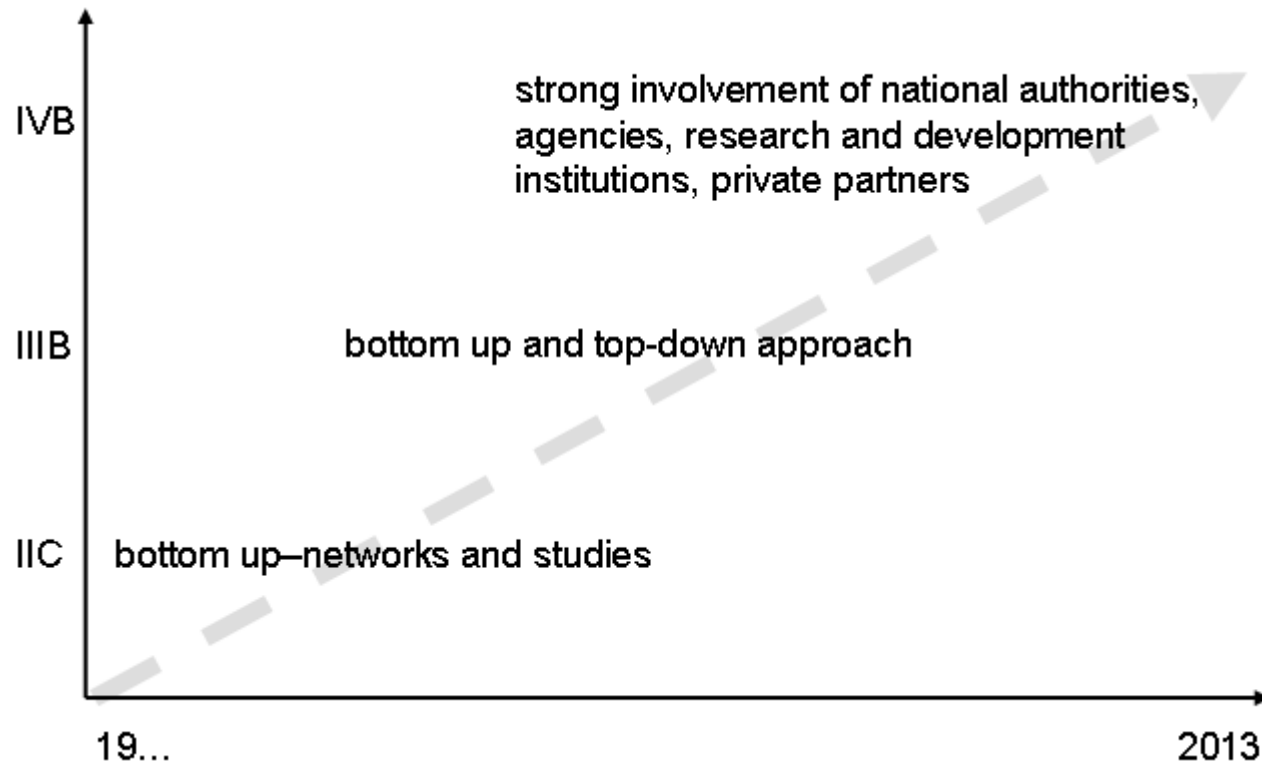

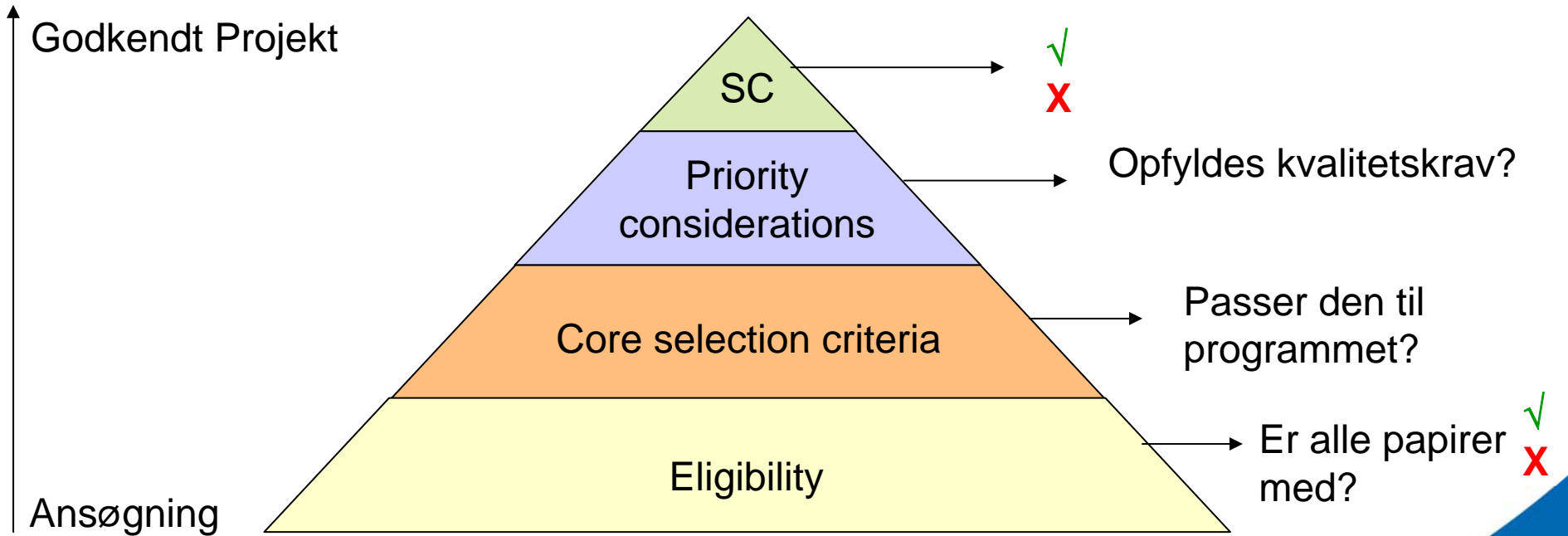
