What is their business?

From 2021 Northside Festival is changing location. This will make a massive change on the energy usage and the way the festival is powered. Today everything from food trucks to concerts are powered by diesel generators, which is the case for most festivals. In 2021, with the new location, Northside will be connected to the public energy grid infrastructure. This leads to an immediate improvement, but is it enough? The answer is no. At peak loads the new electricity infrastructure will only be able to cover up to 70 % of the energy consumption according to a report from Rambøll Consulting for DTD group and the Municipality of Aarhus.





What are they looking for?

DTD group is looking for innovators who have solutions or ideas that, as a minimum, can be implemented and tested as a back-up source to cover individual sites concerts in peak periods. Preferably solutions that are scalable/adaptable for other concert events, that does not have the same infrastructure available as Northside Festival. The vision is to change how festivals are powered.
