Get involved!

At this year's conference we are going to explore how to connect people, organisations, cities and regions within the North Sea Region. These connections should lead to smarter regions and sustainable growth opportunities. Connections can at the same time be physical, virtual, direct or indirect, formal or informal and one of the leading questions will be how the concept of corridors can help to interconnect the North Sea Region better.

Taking the North Sea Commission's 2020 strategy and the Interreg North Sea Region Programme's main project priorities into account the North Sea Conference 2017 will focus on four main strands:

Sustainable Growth Corridors to

- 1) Manage Space in the North Sea Region
- 2) Cooperate on tackling the impacts of climate change in the North Sea Region
- 3) Be accessible by clean transport
- 4) Build the North Sea Region as an attractive and sustainable community

Taking the current discussion about the future of cooperation in Europe into account a fifth main strand will focus on the existing status and what it means for the future of the North Sea Region:

- 5) What does cooperation mean for the North Sea Region and how to organize it in the future?

What can I do?

We want you to get involved in the preparation and the running of the conference! If you are interested we want you to take an active role by offering a speech, a presentation, a discussion round or by presenting an idea for a new project or by exhibiting an outcome of your North Sea project within one of the five conference strands. The earlier we know about your plans the better we can integrate them in the conference programme.

Once we have received all ideas and proposals for active participation we will include them in the programme. We are aiming to make it interactive and interesting so it becomes an inspiring experience for every participant.
